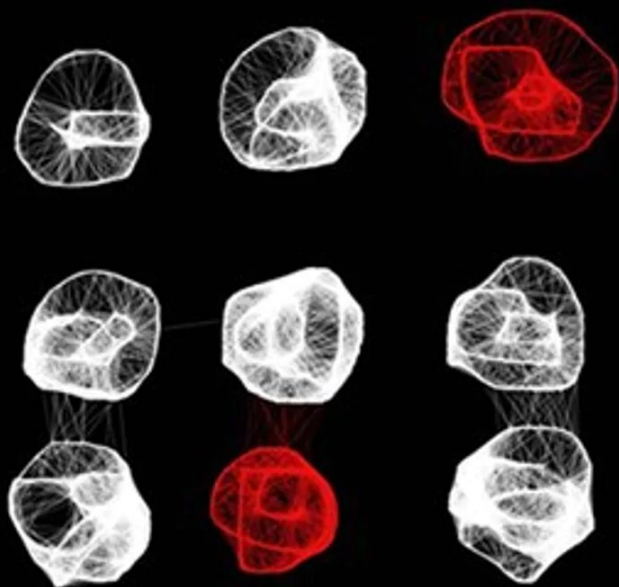

Sources of Impurity

1. Lepra (skin disease)
2. Genital Discharges (of blood or semen)
3. Corpses (dead bodies)

Numbers 12:10-12

10 When the cloud lifted from above the tent, Miriam's skin was leprous—it became as white as snow. Aaron turned toward her and saw that she had a defiling skin disease, 11 and he said to Moses, “Please, my lord, I ask you not to hold against us the sin we have so foolishly committed. 12 Do not let her be like a stillborn infant coming from its mother's womb with its flesh half eaten away.”

Jesus vs. Death

1. *Mark 1:40-45*: Jesus heals a leper
2. *Mark 5:24-34*: Jesus heals a bleeding woman on the way to raising a little girl (corpse) from the dead

Mark 1:21-28

1. There are forces inside us that threaten to control us

3. It is confrontation with the words of Jesus that draws out of us the Death that lies within
